At Bogangar Public School our gates have and will continue to be open for community use. Currently our school facilities are used by the Cabarita Garden Club, Top Dog Academy, Charity Boxing and Rhee Tae Kwon Do as well as sporting groups. However, the biggest service operating at the school is the Outside School Hours Care, known to many over the years as Madsport but in 2018 had an operational name change to Free Bees.

This critical service, being offered to our local families is managed by Leah Cranston and provides before and after school care and only just last year extended that service to include vacation care. Unfortunately, at the end of January 2019, Leah has decided not to renew her lease, meaning that Free Bees will cease to operate.

However saddened as we are, can I reassure you that a process is already underway to engage a new provider that will continue to open our hall doors to families who are in need of care for their children outside school hours. The school is doing everything possible to enable a timely and smooth transition at the end of January to avoid a gap in the service.

I would like to on behalf of Bogangar Public School, to sincerely thank Leah and her team for the care provided to the children over the many years and wish her well in future endeavours.

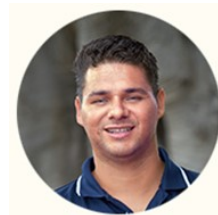
